









Dear Parents and Carers.

The 2018 St Mary's Swimming Carnival will be held on **Wednesday 12th December** at Granville Swimming Centre (Enid Avenue, Granville). The carnival is compulsory for students in Years 2 to Year 6. **Year 1 students turning 8 Years of age in 2019 are also eligible to participate in the carnival if they wish to trial for the 2019 Zone Swimming Team. These children are unable to participate in 25m races and structured play events on the day, so please ensure they are competitive 50m swimmers. An educational sports carnival will be organised at school for students in Kindergarten and the remaining Year 1 students. The cost for the Swimming Carnival has been included in the school fees. There is no entry fee for spectators.**

Students will travel to the carnival with their teachers. Buses will leave school at 9:00am to commence the carnival at 9:30am. Please be at school at the normal time. Those students competing in the 100m Freestyle events will need to be at school before 8:20am, as their bus will leave at 8:30am. Buses will return to school by 2:30pm. Parents are permitted to take their children from the pool at the conclusion of the carnival. The children will need to have their name marked off the class list prior to their leaving the pool. If your child is going home with another parent, a note must be sent with your child on the day.

Students must wear their swimming costumes to school under their school sports uniform on the day. Students may wear coloured clothing, which is consistent with their house colour. Thongs or sandals may also be worn. Please make sure all clothing, towels etc are marked with your child's name. Recess and lunch must be supplied from **home** in a bag clearly marked with your child's name. **No crepe paper can be taken to the pool.** Please ensure your child has sunscreen and a hat, as Granville Swimming Centre is an outdoor pool.

Please familiarise your child with the following guidelines that have been put in place to allow the day to run smoothly.

- 1. Championship points will be calculated from the top four place getters in each event across all heats. There are no finals.
- 2. Students will be placed into their nominated swimming events.
- 3. Only the 50m and 100m events count towards the championship points and Age Champions. Only students aged 8 12 years next year are eligible for Age Champions.
- 4. Children in the 50m and 100m events will be disqualified for incorrect style and strokes as this is the practice for Zone and Diocesan Carnivals.
- 5. There are qualifying times for each event at the Zone Carnival. If a student comes 1st or 2nd at the school carnival, there is no guarantee of competing at the Zone carnival.
- Medals will be awarded for Age Champions and Runners Up. Year 6 students are not eligible to be Age Champions or qualify for the Zone Carnival. They will be awarded points and place ribbons for their events.

NO CHILD WILL BE ALLOWED TO ATTEND WITHOUT A SIGNED PERMISSION SLIP.

The permission slip must be returned by Monday, 19th November.

Attached is a Swimming Carnival Permission and Event Nomination Form. Please fill out all events your child will be entering and return this to school no later than Monday.19th November. No children will be placed into an event without this signed permission form being returned.

NO LATE FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.


