

MR BLISSENDEN'S HOLIDAY CHALLENGE

PRODUCE A PORTRAIT



During the holidays you are invited to produce a **portrait**. A portrait is a painting or drawing of a person, especially one depicting only the face or head and shoulders.

The portrait should be of a **person who is special to you** – someone who is known to you, who knows you and plays a significant role in your life.

You **must** include a written description about **why** this person is important to you on another A4 sheet of paper. Use descriptive words. Write or type your description and staple it to your portrait - add your name and class. One prize per grade (lucky raffle draw) and all portraits will be displayed.

- One artwork only per student.
- Must be on paper (NOT board).
- Must be unmounted and unframed.
- Must be no smaller / no larger than A4.
- Can be vertical or horizontal.
- Any art materials may be used (eg paint, pencil, pastels, paper collage) but the artwork must be two-dimensional.
- You are encouraged to refine your work by completing multiple drafts before the final portrait is completed.
- Ask mum and dad to take you to the Archibald Prize Exhibition at the Art Gallery of NSW.
- Bring your completed portrait and description to school on day 1, Term 3.
